### Special Notices

#### PERSONAL PROPERTY

Students bring valuable property to school at their own risk. The general School Insurance Policy does not indemnify individual students against loss through theft or damage to their personal property at school.

Boarders are asked to register details of valuable items with House Staff for purposes of record and identification.

Clothing and personal property should be marked with the owner's name.

Students may operate personal accounts at the School Bank, which opens at lunch-time each weekday during term.

Day students and boarders may use their own padlocks to secure games lockers and tuck boxes (for boarders). (It is prudent to have a second key available for use in the event that the first key is mislaid.) The school will provide locks for book lockers.

#### AEROSOLS

Boarders who wish to bring back aerosol products for use in dormitory areas are reminded that misdirected use of aerosols can cause damage and over-use in confined spaces can be injurious to health. This also applies to aerosol use in sports changing rooms. All students are encouraged to seek alternatives to the use of aerosols, for both safety and environmental reasons.

#### CORRECTION FLUIDS

The use of Tipp-Ex and Pentel related products is prohibited at school and students should not bring such products to school.

#### SPORTS SAFETY

Sports coaches advise that games players should wear the appropriate protective gear such as gum shields and shin guards.

Protective gear should be purchased under the professional guidance of recognised retailers.
